INVESTIGATION SYNOPSIS

On April 21, 2021, Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) Criminal Investigations Division (CID) Special Agent (SA) Patrick Alonzo was assigned a lead by Lieutenant Daniel Martinez and Major Ortiz where legislative aid Mackenzie Poston alleged that her [Poston] and committee clerk Jennifer Reeves believed they had been drugged by lobbyists at the Austin Club.

The following is general information Poston told Major Ortiz and Lt. Martinez. Poston stated on 4/2/21 she [Poston], Committee Clerk Jennifer Reeves and Chief of Staff Ben Lancaster were invited to the Austin Club by Richard Dennis who is a lobbyist with Hillco Partners. Upon arrival, the Austin Club was empty and they proceeded to the bar area where two more Hillco lobbyist, J McCart and Kyle were present. Poston did not know the last name of Kyle. Poston advised that she [Poston] had one Chillton drink which includes club soda, lemonade, and vodka (alcohol). Poston states that at one point she [Poston] went to the restroom and upon return there was another Chillton drink at the table that she [Poston] did not order. Poston began consuming this second drink then doesn't remember anything after that point. Poston stated that the next day Jennifer Reeves tested positive for GHB. Poston was adamant that there was no sexual assault. End of Summary.

SA Alonzo will attempt to field the case with the Austin Police Department (APD) Sex Crimes Unit and assist detectives with the investigation.

- On April 22, 2021 at approximately 1:40 PM, Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) Criminal Investigations Division (CID) Special Agent (SA) Patrick Alonzo made contact with Mackenzie Poston, victim alleging to have been drugged at The Austin Club, to set up an interview.
 - 2. Poston advised SA Alonzo that Poston could not meet with SA Alonzo due to scheduled hearings.
 - Poston subsequently agreed to meet with SA Alonzo on April 23, 2021 at 1:30 PM at the DPS Capitol District Office (CDO) located at 1500 N. Congress Avenue, Austin, Texas 78701.
 - 4. Although the investigation was in the beginning stages, SA Alonzo made contact with the DPS Victims and Employee Support Services (VESS) to bring awareness that assistance would likely be necessary.
 - 5. SA Alonzo took no further action on this date.
 - 6. This investigation is ongoing.

- On April 23, 2021, at approximately 1:30 PM, Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) Criminal Investigations Division (CID) Special Agent (SA)
 Patrick Alonzo and Lieutenant Daniel Martinez met with Mackenzie Poston at the DPS Capitol District Office (CDO) located at 1500 N. Congress Avenue, Austin, Texas 78701.
 - SA Alonzo recorded the interview with a body camera. The video will be documented as Non-Drug Exhibit S2.P1. Refer to Non-Drug Exhibit S2.P1 for exact and chronological statements.
 - 3. The following is a summary of the interview with Poston:

Poston stated that Poston worked in State Representative Brooks Landgraf's office as a legislative aide. On Friday April 2, 2021, at approximately 4:30 PM, Richard Dennis called the office phone advising Poston there was a bunch of lobbyists at The Austin Club inviting Benjamin Lancaster, Jennifer Reeves and Poston over to have drinks. Lancaster, Reeves, and Poston came to a consensus to go to The Austin Club and ride together. Upon arrival, Poston stated the club was completely empty except for the three lobbyists in the corner booth. Poston stated that there's always staffers and legislators doing social and business meetings and that Poston thought it was strange that it was just Lancaster, Reeves, Poston and the three lobbyists [Richard Dennis, Joseph McCartt, and Kyle Mauro].

Poston stated that both Poston and Reeves ordered a Chilton drink and got the first down. Poston and Reeves then went to the restroom and on the way back the bartender was bringing Poston and Reeves a second drink. Poston did not think that Poston, Lancaster and Reeves would be staying at The Austin Club the entire evening. Poston stated that soon after beginning the second drink Reeves and Poston both stated, "this one tastes a little different," thinking maybe it's more club soda or more vodka but then a quarter of the way through Poston blacked out.

Poston stated that apparently Poston had called an Uber and left. Poston stated that Poston knew Poston's tolerance and didn't think Poston would be like that after one and one-half drinks. Poston stated Poston got home to her boyfriend, Josh Larson. Larson knew something wasn't right stating, Poston was hallucinating and was very irate, talking to Ben and Jennifer as if both were in the room with Poston. Poston went on to state that Larson's account was that Poston's eyes were dilated and did not react to light. Larson was ultimately able to get Poston into bed.

Poston stated that Reeves' night continued with Reeves going to another bar with the lobbyists. Poston was adamant that there was no sexual assault to either Poston or Reeves. Reeves blacked out at that bar where another capitol staffer, Jarred Shaffer saw Reeves in distress and Shaffer knew where Reeves lived and took Reeves home.

Poston stated that in between the hours of 6:00 PM and 5:00 AM the following morning, Poston had no recollection of what happened. The next morning Poston did not feel well and feelings of being ill grew progressively worse throughout the day. Poston recalled the symptoms of dehydration, throwing

up every 5 to 10 minutes, could not walk or standup straight, and could not hold Poston's phone.

Poston went to the emergency room where Poston was informed that the lab did not have the capability of testing for date-rape drugs. Poston was in the hospital for (6) six hours in excruciating pain while being treated for dehydration, stomach pain and given nausea medication. Poston went on to state that at one point Poston just wanted to die because it hurt to breathe, sit up, and to stand. Medical staff at the hospital told Poston that if Poston was slipped this drug, this would be signs of an overdose.

Poston got home that night trying to put the pieces together questioning, "did we drink that much?" Reeves stated that Reeves had no idea what happened. Reeves told Poston that Reeves went to a clinic in town and tested positive for GBH [GHB].

Poston stated that Poston did know the name of the lobbyists that were there at The Austin Club. Poston specifically wanted to talk about Dennis who Poston stated had a very bad reputation, of which Poston did not know at the time. Poston had received a report of another capitol staffer that had a list of inappropriate comments that Dennis had made. Poston advised, this report consisted of sexual comments and went on to state that Dennis was sleazy to Poston. Poston stated, "he doesn't have a great reputation." Poston stated that Dennis had been a frequent flyer in Representative Landgraf's office and was always a nuisance.

Poston named Rick Dennis, Joseph McCartt and Kyle Mauro as the three lobbyists and stated that all three work for HillCo, which Poston defined as a lobbying firm. Poston stated that Mauro was extremely drunk when Mauro arrived at The Austin Club.

Poston described The Austin Club as a bar/restaurant about a block away from the Capitol. Poston stated that being a member or knowing a member is a requirement for entering the Club. Poston went on to describe the layout of The Austin Club as being a hotel lobby and as you enter to the right is a bar area with tables and a couple of booths.

The only occupants of The Austin Club was the bartender, the three lobbyists, Poston, Reeves and Lancaster, which Poston found to be strange. Poston stated that Poston, Reeves and Lancaster got to The Austin Club shortly after 5:00 PM. Poston clarified the only three staffers in attendance were Poston, Reeves and Lancaster. Poston stated Lancaster drove Reeves and Poston to The Austin Club in Lancaster's older model Ford F-150 pick-up. Poston sat in the back seat and Reeves sat in the front passenger seat.

Poston stated that Poston and Reeves' first drinks were received between 5:10 PM and 5:15 PM, and the second drinks were received at around 5:30 PM to 5:40 PM. Poston stated that Poston was home by 6:30 PM. Poston stated Poston blacked out around 6:00 PM.

Poston stated that Reeves and Poston only ordered the first round of drinks and that the bartender just brought out the second round of drinks. Poston recalled most of the conversations pertaining to business and later talking about hobbies. Poston stated the last thing Poston remembered was a conversation about golf and small talk with Dennis.

Poston stated that Reeves went to Caroline's with Dennis and McCartt. Mauro and Lancaster did not go to Caroline's. Reeves told Poston that Reeves blacked out once at Caroline's. Coincidentally another capitol staffer, Jarred Shaffer was at Caroline's and saw that Reeves looked extremely intoxicated and helped Reeves to get home. Poston stated Reeves and the lobbyists went on foot from The Austin Club to Caroline's. Poston provided SA Alonzo contact information for DENNIS and Reeves.

Poston stated that Poston had never experienced a date-rape drug. Poston acknowledged some of the detail was from Larson's observation and not Poston's own recollection.

Poston last remembered blacking out at the table. Reeves told Poston that Poston ordered the Uber and that Poston got up on Poston's own to leave. Reeves stated to Poston, "I couldn't tell anything was wrong with you."

Poston reaffirmed that the Chilton, drink is comprised of lemon, vodka and club soda. The second drink ordered was a Chilton also.

Poston stated that Poston observed the bartender bringing the second round of Chilton's out and was actively placing the drink onto the table from the bartender's tray as Poston and Reeves were simultaneously sitting back down on their return from the restroom.

Poston eluded to the bartender being involved with the tampering of the drinks stating, "All of these guys [HillCo Lobbyists] are members of The Austin Club. The bartender was hugging on all of them [HillCo Lobbyists]". Poston advised that Poston did not know how close they [HillCo Lobbyists] were to The Austin Club but was worried the matter would get swept under the rug. Poston states, "It's not far-fetched to think that these guys [HillCo Lobbyists] could have paid the bartender or asked her [the bartender] for something like that because they [HillCo Lobbyists and the bartender] were extremely close that night."

Poston described the bartender as a light-skinned female with dark middle-length curly hair, wearing a black collared shirt and jeans. Poston stated that Representative Landgraf had never really liked Dennis and that Dennis is usually in the office because of Dennis' close relationship with Ben Lancaster who is the Chief of Staff. Poston stated Representative Landgraf was aware of Poston's allegation.

Poston stated that Poston was not a member of The Austin Club and the date of the occurrence would have been Poston's first time there. Poston stated that to gain entry you must be a guest of a member.

Poston recalled there not being a receptionist at the front and that Lancaster, Reeves, and Poston walked straight into The Austin Club. Poston stated that Lancaster had been there several times before.

Poston stated that Poston had worked for Representative Landgraf's office for about a year. Poston stated that Dennis had been banned from the office. Poston stated that before being banned from the office Dennis had visited the office approximately 3 times after this alleged incident at The Austin Club.

SA Alonzo verified with Poston that all of the information and rumors of

inappropriate comments made by Dennis were learned by what Poston had heard and not what Poston had witnessed. Poston stated yes, and that those instances were from the past.

Poston stated that it would have been Reeves second time at The Austin club.

Poston reaffirmed to Lt. Martinez that Poston was already at the table and that Reeves and Poston were sitting down while the bartender was removing the drinks from the bartender's tray to the table in front of Reeves and Poston. Reeves reaffirmed this information. Poston provided contact information for Poston's boyfriend stating, "he knows more than I do."

Poston stated that Poston does not take any medication and has never had any medical experience like what Poston had experienced. Poston stated that Reeves was a lot more hesitant of coming forward and that Reeves mentality is that of, "I would want to forget it happened."

Poston stated Poston's reasons for not coming forward sooner was because Poston was still putting the pieces together, being sick, and feelings of guilt. Poston went on to state that Poston had safety concerns about Poston's safety and retaliation since lobbyists are known to have a lot of money, resources, and connections.

SA Alonzo made Poston aware that a DPS Victim's Services Counselor was available to assist Poston throughout the investigation if Poston was open to the assistance. SA Alonzo informed Poston that a counselor would be following up with Poston independently.

- 4. SA Alonzo noted that Poston's account of how the drinks got to the table were inconsistent with information Poston reported to Major Gabriel Ortiz and Lt. Daniel Martinez while obtaining general information at the infant stages of the investigation.
- 5. SA Alonzo noted, and admittedly by Poston, that much if not all of Poston's account of the night of the incident was reconstructed to Poston by others.
- 6. SA Alonzo will download Non-Drug Exhibit S2.P1 on a USB, DVD, CD, or External Drive to be compiled with all media evidence from this investigation.
- 7. SA Alonzo conducted analytical research to identify Legislative Aide/Committee Clerk Jennifer Reeves, Chief of Staff Benjamin Lancaster, Committee Clerk Jarred Shaffer, and HillCo Partners Lobbyists, Kyle Mauro, Joseph McCartt, and Richard Dennis.
- 8. This investigation is ongoing.

Patrick Alonzo attempted to make contact with Jennifer Reeves, reported victim of assault as alleged by Mackenzie Poston.

- 2. SA Alonzo was unable to make contact and left a voicemail.
- 3. This investigation is ongoing.
- On April 23, 2021, at approximately 7:02 PM, Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) Criminal Investigations Division (CID) Special Agent (SA) Patrick Alonzo continued investigating a reported assault alleged by Mackenzie Poston.
 - 2. SA Alonzo received a screenshot of the Uber ride Poston took from The Austin Club to Poston's residence on 4/02/2021, the night of the alleged assault. (See attachment # S4.A1 Poston Uber Ride)
 - 3. SA Alonzo also received a photo that Poston took the night of the alleged assault. The photo will be referred to as Non-Drug Exhibit S4.P1.
 - 4. The following consist of the verbatim message as received by SA Alonzo from Poston:

"Here are the pictures I have from that night. I guess I was off on the time, it hasn't been very clear to me. Looks like my Uber home was at 8pm. I'm very sorry I was off on that. When you and Josh are able to talk, he will be able to clear that up. I'm still working on a contact for Jay McCartt. I will send that when I find it."

"The picture was taken at 6:37, and I know that was my first drink and probably 20ish minutes into being there. The gentlemen in front of me is the "Kyle" guy I didn't know. The order guy on the right is Jay McCartt. Rick Dennis is not pictured but sitting to the right of me."

"I was able to speak to Donna. She was so quick to contact me! I'm seeing her Thursday at 11am. Thank you, again."

- 5. SA Alonzo noted the significant inconsistencies in the time of the Uber ride [8:03 PM] compared to times mentioned during Poston's interview. SA Alonzo noted the pick-up location for Poston was consistent with The Austin Club and the drop-off location was consistent with Poston's residence.
- Poston verified with SA Alonzo the name and location of the hospital where Poston received treatment was Ascension Seton Medical Center Austin, 1201 W 38th Street, Austin, Texas 78705.
- 7. SA Alonzo will download Non-Drug Exhibit S4.P1 onto a USB, DVD, CD, or External Drive to be compiled with all media evidence from this investigation.
- 8. This investigation is ongoing.

- On April 24, 2021, at 3:07 PM, Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS)
 Criminal Investigation Division (CID) Special Agent (SA) Patrick Alonzo
 canvassed The Austin Club, 110 E 9th St, Austin, Texas 78701 to ascertain
 whether surveillance video could be obtained that was relevant to the
 investigation.
 - 2. The front door of the building was locked, but SA Alonzo observed two overhead cameras that were in position to capture guests entering and exiting the venue.
 - 3. SA Alonzo was subsequently able to gain entry into the club. SA Alonzo went into the bar area and took six photos of the empty bar area. The photos will be referred to as Non-Drug Exhibit S5.P1.
 - 4. SA Alonzo also took a video of the empty bar area for reference. The video will be referred to as Non-Drug Exhibit S5.P2.
 - 5. SA Alonzo while visiting was put in contact with Ken Richardson, General Manager of The Austin Club. Richardson was in New Mexico at the time but offered any and all assistance to SA Alonzo's investigation.
 - 6. SA Alonzo did not provide Richardson the specifics of the investigation, but was able to learn the following summary of administrative information:

The Austin Club prides itself on the privacy of members and guests and therefore there are no cameras inside the venue except directly behind the bar and in the kitchen area. All cameras whether outside or inside do not record as a result of the DVR system being seized during an unrelated investigation. SA Alonzo was able to identify Lupita Gomez, Joseph Jafarian, and Receptionist Debbie Calderon as staff that would have been working when the alleged incident would have occurred in the evening hours of 4/02/2021. Richardson stated there are great records of what drinks are ordered because there are no cash transactions. Richardson was completely forthcoming and cooperative with SA Alonzo. Richardson stated that Richardson would meet SA Alonzo to provide timesheets and bar tabs upon Richardson's return on Tuesday, April 27, 2021.

- 7. SA Alonzo spoke with Gomez, Jafarian and Calderon while actively working. Gomez and Calderon agreed to meet with SA Alonzo on Sunday April 25, 2021. Jafarian subsequently agreed to meet with SA Alonzo on Monday, April 26, 2021.
- 8. SA Alonzo will download Non-Drug Exhibits S5.P1 and S5.P2 onto a USB, DVD, CD, or External Drive to be compiled with all media evidence from this investigation.
- 9. This investigation is ongoing.

- On April 24, 2021, at approximately 4:05 PM, Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) Criminal Investigations Division (CID) Special Agent (SA) Patrick Alonzo was contacted by Mackenzie Poston.
 - 2. SA Alonzo audio recorded the phone conversation. The audio recording will be documented as Non-Drug Exhibit S6.P1. Refer to Non-Drug Exhibit S6.P1 for verbatim chronological statements.

3. The following is a summary of the recorded conversation:

Poston was concerned about the new media attention surrounding the investigation. SA Alonzo encouraged Poston to utilize DPS Victim's Services Counselor Donna Fullilove to assist Poston throughout the course of the investigation.

During the conversation, Poston stated that Ben Lancaster parked on level P2 inside the Capitol Extension Garage. Poston stated that Lancaster would have exited the garage then turned left onto 15th Street then left on Lavaca toward The Austin Club.

Poston told SA Alonzo that Poston would send the discharge paperwork from Ascension Seton Hospital with Josh Larson to give to SA Alonzo at Larson's scheduled interview the following day.

SA Alonzo mentioned to Poston that Reeves had not returned phone calls of both SA Alonzo and DPS Victim's Services. Poston stated, "yea, she's pretty upset with me". Poston stated that Reeves was upset with Poston because of the media attention surrounding the investigation.

- 4. SA Alonzo coordinated with the DPS Austin Communications to identify Poston's Uber driver to be Luis Alberto Martinez Albolay (Albolay).
- 5. SA Alonzo made contact with Albolay who agreed to meet with SA Alonzo at the Capitol District Office (CDO) for an interview.
- 6. SA Alonzo will download Non-Drug Exhibit S6.P1 onto a USB, DVD, CD, or External Drive to be compiled with all media evidence from this investigation.
- 7. This investigation is ongoing.

- Patrick Alonzo and Lieutenant (Lt.) Daniel Martinez (translator) met with Luis Alberto Martinez Albolay (Albolay) at the DPS Capitol District Office, 1500 N. Congress Avenue, Austin, Texas 78701.
- Albolay did arrive in a Toyota Carolla passenger vehicle (LRJ5481). SA Alonzo noted the Corolla was consistent with records provided by Mackenzie Poston. (See attachment S4.A1 - Poston Uber Ride)
- 3. SA Alonzo utilized a body camera to record during the interview with Albolay. The video recording will be documented as Non-Drug Exhibit S7.P1. Refer to Non-Drug Exhibit S7.P1 for verbatim chronological statements.
- 4. The following is a summary of relevant information SA Alonzo obtained during the interview with Albolay:

Albolay stated that Albolay works in areas of Austin that would include downtown. Albolay drives approximately 30 customers per week and further advised not uncommon to encounter customers that would be considered intoxicated. Albolay further explained that Albolay does not always look directly at the customers when the customers get into the vehicle. SA Alonzo showed Albolay the Poston Uber Ride Attachment S4.A1 to which Albolay acknowledged depicted as Albolay, but could not recall the ride. Albolay reviewed Albolay's logs with SA Alonzo and Lt. Martinez however, Albolay could not locate the corresponding ride for April 2, 2021. SA Alonzo requested Albolay check with Uber to pinpoint the day Poston's ride would have occurred.

End of Summary.

- 5. SA Alonzo will download Non-Drug Exhibit S7.P1 onto a USB, DVD, CD, or External Drive to be compiled with all media evidence from this investigation.
- 6. This investigation is ongoing.

- On April 25, 2021, at 9:01 AM, Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS)
 Criminal Investigation Division (CID) Special Agent (SA) Patrick Alonzo and
 SA Brant Johnston conducted an interview with Joshua Larson, boyfriend of
 Mackenzie Poston, at the Hays County Precinct #2 Office located at 5458 FM
 2770, Kyle, Texas 78640.
 - 2. SA Alonzo audio recorded the interview with Larson. The video recording will be documented as Non-Drug Exhibit S8.P1. Refer to Non-Drug Exhibit S8.P1 for verbatim chronological statements.
 - 3. The following is a summary of information obtained from the interview:

Larson was on-duty as a Hays County Sheriff's Deputy during the interview. SA Alonzo told Larson, although Larson was on-duty, Larson was not

compelled to assist with SA Alonzo's investigation and was free to leave.

Larson identified Poston as Larson's girlfriend. Larson stated that both Larson and Poston live together at 516 E Slaughter Lane #201, Austin, Texas and Larson and Poston had lived together for approximately nine (9) months.

Larson stated that on Thursday, April 1, 2021, between the hours of 7:00 PM and 8:00 PM, Larson received a text from Poston asking for help. Larson called Poston who sounded very intoxicated. Poston told Larson that Poston was in an Uber and on the way home.

Larson, awaiting Poston's arrival, heard banging on the door then heard the garage door closing. Larson stated that when Larson observed Poston that Poston did not appear like Poston's normal self. Poston was hitting the side of the counters and Poston needed help walking and standing. Larson recalls Poston attempting to take off Poston's shirt and pants then tried to go outside. Larson states that Poston was acting drunk and Larson and Poston called Poston's mother and subsequently called Poston's father. Larson stated Poston appeared as if Poston was hallucinating and talking to Ben and Jennifer as if Ben and Jennifer were there.

Larson stated that throughout the night Poston threw up at least fifty (50) times. The next morning, Poston had no recollection of what happened the night prior. Larson stated that both Larson and Poston assumed that Poston had been drugged, but Poston did not want to make a report.

Larson stated Poston could not hold down food or water and was trembling prompting Larson to take Poston to the hospital. Poston continued to throw up at the hospital. Larson stated at some point Rick texted Poston about golf.

SA Alonzo asked for a more detailed description of Larson's observation of Poston the night of the alleged drugging. Larson stated Poston smelled like alcohol and appeared intoxicated. Larson stated Poston's speech was slurred and Poston's eyes were red and glossy. Larson further stated that Poston was stumbling while walking and could hardly stand up. Larson stated Poston displayed "all the signs indicating intoxication."

Larson stated that when both Larson and Poston go out Larson and Poston do not drink much or get intoxicated. Larson stated that Larson took a phone light and put it above Poston's eyes approximately eight (8) inches and Poston's pupils did not move.

SA Alonzo clarified with Larson that the date of the alleged assault was Thursday, April 1, 2021 and the hospital visit was Friday, April 2, 2021. SA Alonzo corroborated this when taking a photo of Poston's text to Larson on the night of the alleged assault.

Larson provided SA Alonzo with Poston's discharge paperwork from Poston's visit. (See attached S8.A1 - Poston Discharge Paperwork)

- 4. SA Alonzo's photo of the text between Larson and Poston will be documented as Non-Drug Exhibit S8.P2.
- 5. SA Alonzo will download Non-Drug Exhibits S8.P1 and S8.P2 onto a USB,

DVD, CD, or External Drive to be compiled with all media evidence from this investigation.

6. This investigation is ongoing.

- On April 25, 2021, at approximately 11:00 AM, Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) Criminal Investigations Division (CID) Special Agent (SA) Patrick Alonzo and (SA) Brant Johnston went to Caroline Restaurant located at 621 Congress Avenue Suite 101, Austin, Texas 78701.
 - 2. SA Alonzo subsequently met with General Manager Mindi Marshall. Marshall provided SA Alonzo with a list of all employees that would have been working around the bar on April 1, 2021 during the evening hours. (See attachment S9.A1 Caroline Restaurant Timesheet)
 - 3. Marshall also checked the DVR system to see if there would be video surveillance for the evening of April 1, 2021. Marshall was able to retrieve video, but told SA Alonzo that a subpoena would be needed to release said records or bar tabs.
 - SA Alonzo told Marshall that SA Alonzo would follow-up with a grand jury subpoena.
 - 5. This investigation is ongoing.
- On April 25, 2021, at approximately 2:00 PM, Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) Criminal Investigations Division (CID) Special Agent (SA)
 Patrick Alonzo met with Lupita Gomez, evening bartender for The Austin Club, at the DPS Capitol District Office (CDO) located at 1500 N Congress Avenue, Austin, Texas 78701.
 - 2. SA Alonzo video recorded the interview with Gomez. The video recording will be documented as Non-Drug Exhibit S10.P1. Refer to Non-Drug Exhibit S10.P1 for verbatim chronological statements.
 - 3. The following is a summary of the interview.

Gomez stated that Gomez is the head bartender and was in the bar most of the time. Gomez stated that Gomez works most evenings. Gomez stated that Gomez had been a bartender for approximately twenty (20) years.

Gomez stated, "There was a direct correlation between activity at The Austin Club and that of the Texas State Capitol. Customers consisted of lobbyists, senators, judges, and governors".

Gomez stated that Gomez treats all customers the same.

Gomez stated that Gomez does talk to J. [Joseph] McCartt outside of what would be considered a normal bartender to customer relationship. Gomez allowed SA Alonzo to review these text messages and SA Alonzo found the text messages to be non-nefarious in nature. Gomez stated that Gomez has never seen McCartt outside of work but just corresponded with text messages.

Gomez stated, "the members of HillCo Partners were in The Austin Club often before going home". Gomez stated that Gomez did not realize the members of HillCo Partners were lobbyists until a couple months ago.

Gomez stated that if Gomez were to stop being employed by The Austin Club, Gomez would never see the members of the club again.

Gomez stated that Gomez had never encountered lobbyists of HillCo Partners outside of work. Gomez stated that members of HillCo Partners were always respectful and very sweet anytime at The Austin Club to include Richard Dennis.

Gomez stated that Gomez mainly bartends alone, making and serving the drinks. Gomez stated her normal workdays are Tuesday through Saturday.

Gomez recalled working on Thursday, April 1, 2021 working with Dustin Wallace. Gomez stated Thursdays and Fridays are usually pretty quiet, but this particular Thursday was a steady night.

Gomez verified that members put all charges on the respective member's account to be charged at the end of the month.

Gomez knew general information of what drinks were ordered on April 1, 2021.

Gomez stated that Gomez had never been asked to put anything into a customer's drink and if seen it would stand out to Gomez.

Gomez stated that Gomez tries to pay attention to women in The Austin Club and knows the difference between being intoxicated and "something else being wrong." Gomez stated that Gomez was drugged when Gomez was twenty-eight (28) years old.

SA Alonzo told Gomez the investigation was involving a matter reported to have occurred at The Austin Club on Thursday, April 1, 2021.

Gomez stated, "Those exact drinks, I know the night and the day you are talking about and I made every single one of those."

When referring to HillCo lobbyists, Gomez stated, "they [HillCo Lobbyists] are all really respectful and if something like that happened I'm pretty positive it wasn't at AC [The Austin Club]."

Gomez reiterated that Gomez is very observant of women and Gomez tries to stay on top of Gomez's tables as well as how customers are acting. Gomez stated that Gomez's supervisor is the same way.

Gomez stated, "A Chilton drink is comprised of vodka, lemon juice, simple

syrup, and club soda".

Gomez stated, "The girls had one double then I switched them to singles."

Gomez stated, "business was really slow that day...everyone was drinking pretty heavily."

Gomez stated, "The girls, Richard Dennis, and another non-HillCo boy were talking about going somewhere after The Austin Club."

Gomez stated, "The area the group was sitting at is known as the HillCo Table." Gomez described it as once you walk into the bar the table is on the far left.

Gomez stated, "Richard Dennis introduced the two girls to Gomez".

SA Alonzo detected no deception during the interview.

- On April 25, 2021, at 3:48 PM, Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS)
 Criminal Investigation Division (CID) Special Agent (SA) Patrick Alonzo conducted a phone interview with Crystal Dickson, mother of Mackenzie Poston.
 - 2. SA Alonzo audio recorded the interview with Dickson. The recording will be documented as Non-Drug Exhibit S11.P1. Refer to Non-Drug Exhibit S11.P1 for verbatim chronological statements.
 - The following is a summary of the interview:

Dickson stated at approximately 9:30 PM, Joshua Larson, boyfriend of Poston, video messaged Dickson. Dickson stated that Poston, from Dickson's observations through the video message, was erratic and not herself [Poston]. Dickson stated Poston was very mad and Dickson thought, "did you [Poston] drink too much?" Dickson further believed that the cause of Poston's behavior was something more than drinking alcohol.

Dickson stated the next morning, around 6:00 AM or 7:00 AM, Poston became sick and by 9:00 AM or 10:00 AM, Larson made the decision to take Poston to the hospital.

Dickson stated that Dickson texted Jennifer and stated, "you gotta be honest...did you girls drinks too much last night?" Jennifer tells Dickson that they [Reeves and Poston] only had 1.5 drinks and that Reeves had never been that sick in Reeves' life.

Reeves told Dickson that Reeves went to the Signature Care, which Dickson knew to be in the area of where both Poston and Reeves lived.

Dickson stated the hospital was not able to test Poston, but Jennifer did get a test that came back positive for the drug GHB.

Dickson stated that Dickson did not know what Reeves' reluctance was in talking with SA Alonzo. Dickson stated it could possibly be due to Reeves' belief that it could hurt Reeves' career since both Reeves and Poston are very young.

Dickson went on to say that Reeves and Reeves' boyfriend have some problems. Dickson stated, "one, she could be worried that it would hurt her career...she and her boyfriend have some problems and I think that she's a little concerned that that's going to be divulged in this, which is why she did not want to have a rape kit done...! hate to say that but that is 100% the truth".

SA Alonzo asked Dickson to elaborate further. Dickson stated, Reeves had been talking to a lobbyist, unrelated to the lobbyist SA Alonzo is investigating. "There's a lobbyist in the capitol that she has been meeting with, dating. She also lives with a guy. They lived together for many years, and I think they've probably had sex. That night that happened with these two girls; Mackenzie Ubered home but Jennifer did not go home with Kenzie [Poston] ...she went to this other lobbyist's that she's been having sex with. She went to his home and that's where she woke up the next day. So she would not want to have a rape kit done because she probably had sex. Obviously, her not coming home that night, her boyfriend was very mad. Only a mom is going to tell you that... based on what I know she went to this other lobbyist's that's she's been having sex with and did not come home. I know about that from Mackenzie."

Dickson did not know the name of the lobbyist, but thought the name was Jarred, and said Poston would know.

Dickson corroborated the date of the alleged assault was April 1, 2021.

- 4. Dickson later sent SA Alonzo ten (10) screenshots of a text thread between Dickson and Reeves on the morning of April 2, 2021. SA Alonzo observed screenshot nine (9) to show Reeves stated the following to Dickson, "Just got home, they found GHB in my blood but nothing in my urine."
- 5. SA Alonzo will assign the ten (10) screenshots as Non-Drug Exhibit S11.P2.
- 6. SA Alonzo will download Non-Drug Exhibits S11.P1 and S11.P2 onto a USB, DVD, CD, or External Drive to be compiled with all media evidence from this investigation.
- 7. This investigation is ongoing.
- On April 25, 2021, at 4:10 PM, Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS)
 Criminal Investigations Division (CID) Special Agent had a recorded phone conversation with Mackenzie Poston, victim in alleged assault.
 - 2. The audio recording will be documented as Non-Drug Exhibit S12.P1. Refer

to Non-Drug Exhibit S12.P1 for verbatim chronological statements.

- 3. The following is a summary of the interview.
- 4. SA Alonzo followed up on information obtained since last speaking with Poston. Poston clarified that the date of the alleged assault was Thursday, April 1, 2021.
- 5. Poston stated that she [Poston] had never been in direct contact with Jarred [Shaffer] but she [Poston] knew that he [Shaffer] was a Committee Clerk for the State Affairs Committee. Poston identified Mason Pigman as Jennifer Reeves's boyfriend. Poston identified Shaffer as Reeves' "side-piece." Poston stated that Reeves told her [Poston] that Jarred was at Caroline Restaurant the night of 4/1/21.
- 6. SA Alonzo asked Poston of what she [Poston] knew of the night after Shaffer and Reeves left Caroline Restaurant. Poston stated, ""What I know to be 100% is she [Reeves] did not make it home that night according to her [Reeves] boyfriend...well her [Reeves'] boyfriend called me the next morning and basically she [Reeves] was having me [Poston] cover for her [Reeves] which makes me [Poston] think she [Reeves] did not end up at her [Reeves] house like she [Reeves] had said previously...but she [Reeves] did text me [Poston] the next day and say Mason [Pigman] who is her [Reeves] boyfriend is about to call you [Poston] can you [Poston] tell him [Pigman] I [Reeves] ended up at your [Poston's] place and he [Pigman] called me [Poston] and I [Poston]could not cover for her [Reeves]..."
- 7. Reeves stated there was no correspondence between Reeves and Poston that indicated Reeves tested positive for the drug GHB. Poston stated that Reeves never expressed any concern to Poston that Shaffer drugged or sexually assaulted her [Reeves]. Poston that she [Poston] and Reeves had talked the day prior [4/24/21].Poston stated the infidelity could be the reason as to why Reeves was not cooperating with SA Alonzo's investigation.
- 8. End of Summary.
- 9. SA Alonzo noted that Reeves was actively talking with Poston during the investigation but had not returned SA Alonzo's phone calls.
- 10. SA Alonzo will download Non-Drug Exhibit S12.P1 onto a USB, DVD, CD, or External Drive to be compiled with all media evidence from this investigation.
- 11. This investigation is on-going.
- On April 25, 2021, at 4:37 PM, Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) Criminal Investigations Division (CID) Special Agent (SA) Patrick Alonzo and Lieutenant Daniel Martinez received correspondence from Luis Martinez Albolay, Mackenzie's Poston's Uber, that Uber records further indicate the date of Poston's Uber ride was on 4/1/21 and not 4/2/21.
 - 2. The investigation is on-going.

 Criminal Investigations Division (CID) Special Agent (SA) Patrick Alonzo met with Debbie Calderon, front receptionist at The Austin Club, at the Capitol District Office (CDO), 1500 N Congress Avenue, Austin, Texas 78701.
 - 2. SA Alonzo video recorded the interview with Calderon. The video recording will be documented as Non-Drug Exhibit S14.P1. Refer to Non-Drug Exhibit S14.P1 for verbatim chronological statements.
 - 3. The following is a summary of the interview.

Calderon stated that Calderon had worked at The Austin Club for five (5) years as a receptionist. Calderon's workstation is in the front/main entrance area of The Austin Club within full view of members and guests that enter or exit. Calderon stated that members occasionally enter the club from the side alley entry but that is rare.

Calderon stated that members are not required to check-in and will often bypass the front reception desk. Calderon stated there is no protocol that would require members to check-in.

Calderon stated that Calderon's shifts are Tuesday through Saturday starting at 3:00 PM to closing around 8:00 PM depending on the activity of the club. Calderon stated that Calderon worked on 4/1/2021 but Calderon could not recall anything from that day.

Calderon stated that Calderon had never encountered anyone that Calderon believed had been drugged nor recalls an instance where a drugging would have occurred at the club. Calderon stated that Calderon would occasionally observe those that had too much to drink.

Calderon stated that Calderon had never seen any misconduct by members, to include lobbyists, while at The Austin Club. Calderon does not conduct any business or work from members outside of The Austin Club.

- 4. SA Alonzo will download Non-Drug Exhibit S14.P1 onto a USB, DVD, CD, or External Drive to be compiled with all media evidence from this investigation.
- 5. This investigation is ongoing.

- Patrick Alonzo went to Ascension Seton Hospital, 1201 W 38th Street, Austin, Texas to follow-up on information provided by Mackenzie Poston, victim in alleged assault.
- 2. SA Alonzo spoke with the nurse supervisor to confirm that the hospital does not test for drugs such as GHB or Rohypnol corroborating information Poston told SA Alonzo.
- 3. The nurse further stated that blood vials are only stored for a period of five (5) days therefore the vials of Poston would not be available.
- 4. This investigation is on-going.

- On April 25, 2021, at approximately 5:46 PM, Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) Criminal Investigations Division (CID) Special Agent (SA) Patrick Alonzo attempted to make contact with Jennifer Reeves, reported victim in alleged assault.
 - 2. SA Alonzo's attempt was not successful and a voicemail message was left.
 - 3. This investigation is on-going.
- On April 25, 2021, at approximately 6:51 PM, Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) Criminal Investigations Division (CID) Special Agent (SA)
 Patrick Alonzo received a phone call from Jennifer Reeves, reported victim of alleged assault.
 - 2. SA Alonzo audio recorded the conversation with Reeves. The audio recording will be documented as Non-Drug Exhibit S17.P1. Refer to Non-Drug Exhibit S17.P1 for verbatim chronological statements.
 - 3. The following is a summary of the conversation.
 - 4. Reeves stated "sorry I was just trying to get through the weekend, yea but I definitely want to talk to you at some point tomorrow if that would work in the morning...I'm usually pretty busy on Mondays but I know this is important and I want to make sure I get you the information." Reeves agreed to meet with SA Alonzo on April 26, 2021 at the DPS Capitol District Office (CDO). Reeves confirmed with SA Alonzo that the SignatureCare located on Slaughter Lane was the facility Reeves was treated at.

- SA Alonzo will download Non-Drug Exhibit S17.P1 onto a USB, DVD, CD, or External Drive to be compiled with all media evidence from this investigation.
- 7. This investigation is on-going.

- On April 25, 2021, at approximately 7:15 PM, Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) Criminal Investigations Division (CID) Special Agent went to SignatureCare Emergency Center located at 5701 W Slaughter Lane G101, Austin, Texas 78749.
 - 2. SA Alonzo talked with Nurse Manager Lindsey Wyancey. Wyancey subliminally confirmed that Reeves had visited the location. SA Alonzo asked Wyancey several hypothetical questions that would illicit SignatureCare protocols and procedures.
 - 3. Wyancey stated that SignatureCare does not test for the drug GHB and in an instance where a patient suspected they [the patient] had been drugged, the patient would be referred to another hospital facility. Wyancey stated the only five (5) drugs that SignatureCare tests on-site are Cocaine, Methamphetamine, PCP, THC, and Benzodiazepines.
 - 4. SA Alonzo noted that it would be administratively impossible for Jennifer Reeves to have tested positive for GHB at the location. This fact would strongly contradict information Reeves reported to Crystal Dickson and consequently Mackenzie Poston.
 - 5. This investigation is on-going.

- On April 26, 2021, at approximately 8:00 AM, Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) Criminal Investigations Division (CID) Special Agent (SA)
 Patrick Alonzo went to the Monitor Room located in the Texas State Capitol, 1100 Congress Avenue, Austin, Texas 78701.
 - 2. SA Alonzo reviewed State Capitol surveillance video from 4/1/21. At 6:20 PM, SA Alonzo observed Mackenzie Poston, Jennifer Reeves and Benjamin Lancaster walking out of the Capitol Building toward the extension elevators which access the attached parking garage.

- Lancaster, Reeves and Poston exit the elevators then are seen walking to Lancaster's pick-up truck. Reeves gets into the front passenger seat and Poston in the rear driver's side seat. Lancaster's truck is then seen driving out of the garage.
- 4. SA Alonzo in review of Poston's and Reeves' disposition in the video did not observe any abnormal behavior.
- 5. SA Alonzo obtained a copy of the surveillance video. The surveillance video will be documented as Non-Drug Exhibit S19.P1.
- 6. SA Alonzo also obtained a badge log for Jarred Shaffer for 4/1/21. (See attachment S19.A1 Shaffer Key Card Log)
- 7. SA Alonzo will download Non-Drug Exhibit S19.P1 onto a USB, DVD, CD, or External Drive to be compiled with all media evidence from this investigation.
- 8. This investigation is on-going.

- 1. On April 26, 2021, at approximately 8:55 AM, Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) Criminal Investigations Division (CID) Special Agent (SA) Patrick Alonzo interviewed Jarred Shaffer, reported witness in the alleged assault.
- 2. The interview was conducted at the Texas State Capitol, 1100 Congress Avenue E2.108, Austin, Texas 78701.
- 3. The interview was audio recorded. The audio recording will be documented as Non-Drug Exhibit S20.P1. Refer to Non-Drug Exhibit S20.P1 for exact and chronological statements.
- 4. The following is a summary of the interview.

On 4/1/2021, Reeves invited Shaffer to Caroline Restaurant. Shaffer met Reeves, Richard Dennis and Jeff Carlson at the Caroline Restaurant at an upstairs table. Shaffer stated that Dennis is Shaffer's former boss. Shaffer stated that Reeves and Shaffer were at the restaurant for a couple hours.

Shaffer stated that at some point during the time at the Caroline Restaurant, Shaffer told Reeves of stories pertaining to Dennis' reputation. Shaffer stated these stories mainly included inappropriate remarks Dennis made to staff at the Capitol. When SA Alonzo asked Shaffer if Shaffer had personal knowledge of Dennis acting out in any of these instances Shaffer stated, "I don't, but I know he doesn't have the best reputation".

When asked about Shaffer's observations Shaffer stated, "I mean maybe I went to the bathroom or something but other than that there's just no way like...I didn't see anything suspicious". Shaffer also stated that Reeves did

not appear uncomfortable.

When asked about the character of lobbyists and those Shaffer encounters, Shaffer responded that Shaffer had "never observed nothing like on a criminal level at all".

Shaffer stated that Reeves, "definitely had been drinking but not out of character...I know that Jennifer [Reeves] felt really bad the next weekend but she [Reeves] had also just got her [Reeves'] COVID shot...I just chalked it up to too many drinks on my end".

Shaffer stated that Shaffer had observed Reeves to appear fine but reiterated that Reeves was definitely inebriated. Shaffer stated that Shaffer had observed Reeves "just to be drinking and that was it".

Shaffer volunteered that Shaffer and Reeves went home together and the next day Reeves felt really bad. Shaffer stated that Shaffer and Reeves were dating at the time but Shaffer nor Reeves were dating anyone else to Shaffer's knowledge. Shaffer stated that Shaffer and Reeves were dating from the beginning of March 2021 to mid-April 2021. Shaffer stated that Reeves had an ex-boyfriend but to Shaffer's knowledge "that was over and done with as far as I was aware".

Shaffer stated that after leaving Caroline Restaurant, Shaffer and Reeves got back to Shaffer's place, Mosaic Apartments in Mueller, around midnight where Shaffer and Reeves had consensual sex. Shaffer stated that Shaffer and Reeves had been intimate several times before the night of 4/1/2021. Shaffer stated that Reeves spent the night at Shaffer's apartment.

Shaffer stated that Shaffer interacted with Reeves the following morning and Reeves and Shaffer had chalked it up to alcohol and getting the COVID shot. Shaffer left Reeves at Shaffer's apartment while Shaffer went to play golf. Reeves eventually took an Uber from Shaffer's house back to Reeves' home.

When specifically referring to Shaffer's account of Reeves' condition on the morning of 4/2/2021 Shaffer stated, "she never insinuated to anything for me to think that something nefarious was going on".

- April 26, 2021, at approximately 11:03 AM, Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) Criminal Investigations Division (CID) Special Agent (SA) Patrick Alonzo conducted an interview with Jennifer Reeves, reported victim in alleged assault, at the DPS Capitol District Office (CDO), 1500 N Congress, Austin, Texas 78701.
- 2. The interview was audio recorded. The audio recording will be documented as Non-Drug Exhibit S21.P1. Refer to Non-Drug Exhibit S21.P1 for exact and chronological statements.

3. The following is a summary of the interview.

SA Alonzo informed Reeves that SA Alonzo is a Special Agent with the DPS Capitol CID. SA Alonzo also informed Reeves that Reeves was free to leave at any point and did not have to meet with SA Alonzo. Reeves stated, "just to be clear, I'm not making a formal report, I'm just wanting to corroborate her [Mackenzie Poston's] story to help the investigation... want to help as much as I can". SA Alonzo noted that this was inconsistent with the phone conversation SA Alonzo had with Reeves the previous day.

Reeves stated that Reeves' position is a committee clerk with Representative Brooks Landgraf's office. Reeves stated that Reeves and Poston are coworkers.

Reeves stated that Reeves and Poston had been talking and trying to piece details together since 4/1/2021.

Reeves stated that on 4/1/2021 they Reeves, Poston, and Ben Lancaster were sitting in the office toward the end of day when Richard Dennis called the office phone inviting them to The Austin Club. Reeves stated that Reeves, Poston, and Lancaster finished up work for another hour before heading to The Austin Club. Reeves stated that both Reeves and Poston respectively consumed one (1) IPA beer before leaving with Lancaster for The Austin Club.

Reeves stated that Lancaster parked directly across the street from The Austin Club. Reeves stated that when Reeves, Poston, and Lancaster entered The Austin Club it was "weird" and that no one else was there except "these group of men". Reeves had only been to The Austin Club one time prior for a social event that sharply contrasted the activity of The Austin Club on this particular day, April 1, 2021.

Reeves stated that there were several lobbyists with HillCo there but Reeves only knew of Richard Dennis. Reeves stated that Lancaster, Poston, and Reeves joined the group of men, which included Dennis, seated in a back corner booth to the left of the bar area. SA Alonzo noted that Reeves immediately offered that Lancaster left the table several times, so Lancaster did not have direct observation of drinks during this meeting.

Reeves stated, "there was one female bartender who was flirty with the men" [lobbyists]. Reeves stated, "we both [Reeves and Poston] ordered

the first Chilton drink while at the table and shortly after a second Chilton drink was brought to the table by the bartender without us [Reeves or Poston] requesting it". Reeves further stated that Reeves did not even see it made.

Reeves could not recall distinct abnormal characteristics of the drink but stated it was saltier than Chilton's that Reeves had before. Reeves also stated that the second drink was stronger [more alcohol] than the first.

Reeves stated that both Reeves and Poston were in observation of both drinks that came to the table. Reeves stated that both Reeves and Poston began sipping on the second Chilton before they decided to both go to the restroom together. Reeves stated, upon Reeves and Poston's return from the bathroom, Reeves did not recall anything afterwards that night.

Reeves stated that Reeves woke up the next morning at Jarred Shaffer's apartment on Shaffer's couch, still in Reeves' same clothes from the night before. Reeves stated that Reeves trusted Shaffer and indicated no concerns of being sexually assaulted. Reeves stated, "it wouldn't be abnormal for him [Shaffer] to meet me and pick me up and take me back to his [Shaffer's] place."

Reeves stated that Reeves then called an Uber that took Reeves home where Mason Pigman, Reeves' boyfriend, was waiting. During this time, Poston tells Reeves, "I think we might have been drugged."

Reeves and Poston then collectively decided to go the hospital. Reeves stated that Pigman drove Reeves to the Signature Care located on Slaughter Lane. The staff of the Signature Care told Reeves that they believed Reeves but did not have the ability to test for GHB on-site. Reeves stated that the doctor told Reeves that Reeves could go to Walgreens to get a test but Reeves did not do.

SA Alonzo asked Reeves about contact information for Pigman. Reeves became noticeably emotional and did not want SA Alonzo to contact Pigman.

SA Alonzo asked Reeves, based on what Reeves recalled from April 1, 2021, who did Reeves believe had the opportunity to place something in Reeves' drink. Reeves stated that anyone sitting at the table would have had the opportunity but went onto to state, "maybe they paid a bartender to slip something in a drink."

SA Alonzo noted that throughout the interview Reeves attempted to sell SA Alonzo the reputation of Richard Dennis rather than articulate facts as to why Dennis or any other lobbyist or person at the table would have placed an adulterant into Reeves or Poston's drink.

4. End of Summary.

5. SA Alonzo noted that most information provided by Reeves contradicted most if not all facts that SA Alonzo had learned in the investigation. Further, SA Alonzo observed Reeves to be very deceptive during the interview. SA Alonzo did not bring these inconsistencies to Reeves' awareness due to it being the initial interview.

Jafarian stated that Jafarian has been the Evening Manager of The Austin Club for eleven (11) years. Jafarian further stated that Jafarian's shift was from 3:00 PM to close of business and Jafarian's days off were Sunday and Monday.

Jafarian stated that it was difficult to distinct members that come into the club. Jafarian further stated they give no special treatment over one member to the next, as a member is a member.

Jafarian stated that members do not have the ability to reserve the bar area during certain hours and would be normal for the bar area to be open during evening hours starting at 3:00 PM.

Jafarian stated it would not be customary for a member to request a particular server or bartender and that Jafarian had never experienced anything like that. Jafarian further stated that a bartender would not be allowed to request a bartender to add an external ingredient to a drink.

Jafarian could not recall, in Jafarian's experience, where a member expressed concerns over the conduct of a bartender at the club.

Jafarian stated that Jafarian does walk around during the shift to keep an eye on everything and that if Jafarian were to observe a member or guest that appeared disoriented, the member or guest would stand out to Jafarian.

Jafarian could not recall the evening of 4/1/2021.

SA Alonzo revealed to Poston the inconsistencies found in the investigation which included Jennifer Reeves' deception to Poston and Crystal Dickson [Poston's mother]. SA Alonzo also told Poston that SA Alonzo believed Poston's assault allegation was built upon said deception by Reeves. SA Alonzo provided factual justification for Poston's behavior and symptoms experienced on 4/1/2021 and 4/2/2021. Poston agreed with SA Alonzo's factual findings, assessments and justifications. Poston acknowledged that Reeves benefited from Poston's belief of being drugged as Reeves needed a

cover story for Reeves' infidelity.

Poston recanted all allegations made against lobbyists associated with HillCo Partners, particularly Richard Dennis.

Poston stated that Poston did not know what happened to Poston that night. Poston stated, "I know something happened to me I just don't know what it was....everything I knew about that night is what people told me."

SA Alonzo asked Poston, "Do you, without a shadow of a doubt, believe that Rick Dennis could have done this?" Poston replied, "I don't, it wasn't my intention in the beginning to accuse anybody."

Poston began crying and stated, "I knew more about Rick and his reputation. It was plausible...I feel like she [Reeves] made up a story and led us to believe we were something we really weren't...there's a dude [Dennis] suffering right now and how she [Reeves] doesn't feel guilty about that I have no idea...I've still been a victim in this and I've still felt bad for that man, my heart breaks for him and his family and to make up a story like that and let this happen...I don't think I would've filed anything if I would've known from the beginning it wasn't what I thought it was."

SA Alonzo asked Poston if there was any reason for SA Alonzo to continue to investigate lobbyists associated with HillCo Partners. Poston replied, "based upon everything that you've told me, no."

Poston further stated, "she [Reeves] had the audacity to lie to you, lie to me, and our boss...that man [Dennis] is probably out of a job, I mean she lied about the whole thing and I'm not okay with that."

 - 4. Pigman stated that on 4/1/21 Reeves told Pigman that she [Reeves] would be going out with coworkers and lobbyists for drinks. Pigman stated that he [Pigman] and Reeves had been dating for three (3) years and that he [Pigman] had never observed her [Reeves] "disappear in the night' like she [Reeves] did that night. Pigman stated that Reeves' was actively sharing her [Reeves] phone location throughout the night which he [Pigman] was tracking.
 - 5. Pigman stated that he [Pigman] and Reeves had never had problems with infedility but he [Pigman] was extremely concerned because of Reeves behavior that night. Pigman stated that Reeves response was abnormal and had never happened in their relationship.
 - 6. Pigman stated that he [Pigman] attempted to contact Reeves 20-25 times that night to no avail. Pigman went to the restaurant Reeves was at but Reeves refused to leave with him [Reeves] and would not tell him [Pigman] her [Reeves'] exact location.
 - 7. Pigman stated that there was only two explanations for Reeves' conduct that night, either Reeves was cheating on Pigman or she [Reeves] had been drugged. Pigman then stated, "then we find out she [Reeves] was drugged."
 - 8. In regards of Reeves' behavior on that night Pigman stated, "it was the most fishy...quite frankly it was bullshit...! was thinking our relationship was over..."
 - 9. Pigman stated Reeves eventually stopped sharing her [Reeves'] location but Pigman's sister could still track her [Reeves] and Reeves gps was moving in the opposite direction of Pigman's apartment.
 - 10. Pigman stated the morning of 4/2/21, at around 9:30 AM, Reeves finally responds to Pigman and came home. Pigman stated that once Reeves returned home she [Reeves'] could not provide a good explanation for her [Reeves] behavior the night prior.
 - 11. Pigman stated that Reeves appearance upon returning home was "distraught, sick, and hungover." Pigman stated that during this time Reeves was talking with the other girl, assumingly Mackenzie Poston, and they decided to go to the hospital to get tested.
 - 12. Pigman stated he [Pigman] drove Reeves to the urgent care but Pigman had to wait in his [Pigman's] truck during the visit. Pigman stated, "she [Reeves] told me [Pigman] that they found a lot of GHB in her blood" via text message. "I've never seen the report, that's what she [Reeves] told me [Pigman]."

13. Pigman stated the he [Pigman] and Reeves don't really talk about that night because it's extremely uncomfortable.

14. End of Summary.

- 15. SA Alonzo will download Non-Drug Exhibit S28.P1 onto a USB, DVD, CD, or External Drive to be compiled with all media evidence from this investigation.
- 16. Pigman subsequently provided the screen capture of Reeves location on the morning of 4/2/21. SA Alonzo noted the location was consistent with the apartment complex of Jarred Shaffer. (See attachment S28.A1 Reeves' location)
- 17. Pigman also provided SA Alonzo a screen capture of Reeves' text message indicating that she [Reeves] had tested positive for GHB while visiting the clinic. (See attachment S28.A2 Reeves text to Mason)

 interviewed Richard Dennis, lobbyist with Hillco Partners, at the Minton Law
 Firm located at 1100 Guadalupe Street, Austin, Texas 78701.
 - 2. SA Alonzo video recorded the interview. The recording will be documented as Non-Drug Exhibit S30.P1. Refer to Non-Drug Exhibit S30.P1 for verbatim chronological statements.
 - 3. The following is a summary of the interview.

Dennis stated that on 4/1/21 he [Dennis] and colleagues had met at the Austin Club to have drinks. Dennis stated it had been a normal busy day and that he [Dennis] extended an invitation to Benjamin Lancaster and subsequently staff members of State Representative Landgraf's office [Jennifer Reeves and

Mackenzie Poston].

Dennis stated that he [Dennis] and Lancaster had a long working relationship but had only known Poston and Reeves for 3-4 months. Dennis stated at the point Reeves, Poston, and Lancaster arrived at the Austin Club they joined him [Dennis] at a table with Jeff Carlson, Jay McCartt, and Kyle Mauro.

Dennis stated it was clear to him [Dennis] that Poston and Reeves were excited about it being the end of the week and were wanting to have a good time. Dennis stated that to his [Dennis'] recollection everyone at the table respectively had four drinks before leaving.

Dennis stated, "in my opinion the two ladies from Landgraf's office were drinking very quickly...the girls were finishing a round every 10-12 minutes."

Dennis identified Lupita Gomez as the bartender. Dennis stated that he [Dennis] had no relationship with Gomez outside of a bartender/customer relationship.

Dennis stated his [Dennis'] last observation of Poston was at the Austin Club when everyone departed around 8:30 PM. Dennis stated that there was discussion of everyone going to Caroline Restaurant.

Dennis and Carlson went to Dennis' vehicle to drop off a brief case then walked to the restaurant. Dennis stated that they [Reeves, Carlson, and Dennis] sat in the upstairs bar area and were surprisingly joined by Jarred Shaffer. Dennis did not know who invited Shaffer but it was clear that someone had.

Dennis stated that a few more drinks were consumed at the restaurant and it was apparent that Reeves and Shaffer were very comfortable with one another. Dennis stated that he [Dennis] observed Shaffer "peck" Reeves on the forehead and cheek. Dennis stated that this conduct would be consistent with those who are in an intimate relationship with one another.

Dennis stated the night continued and once he [Dennis] observed Reeves getting sleepy he [Dennis] thought it was a good point to end the night. Dennis' assumption was everyone was going to go home but also stated, "I assumed given how physically comfortable they were with on another that Jennifer and Jarred were probably going to be going home together..."

Dennis recalled everyone observed throughout the night to be intoxicated by alcohol including himself [Dennis]. Dennis stated that he [Dennis] remembered saying bye to someone after leaving the restaurant then being on the curb and subsequently picked up by an Uber.

Dennis stated that prior to 4/1/21, he had observed intoxicated persons and that no one at the table displayed behavior that would deviate from simply being intoxicated.

SA Alonzo was provided a Polygraph Examination Report conducted by Lafeyette Instrument Company out of the initiative of Dennis' legal representation. SA Alonzo reviewed the report to note questioning was specific to Reeves.

SA Alonzo was provided with Richard Dennis' tabs from the Austin Club and Caroline Restaurant. (See attachment S30.A3 - Richard Dennis Caroline Restaurant Tab)

SA Alonzo did not detect any deception when interviewing Dennis and information provided by Dennis was consistent with information SA Alonzo had obtained throughout the investigation.

 - 3. SA Alonzo at the conclusion of the interview did not deem any information provided by Lancaster to be relevant to the initial allegation of assault.
 - 4. SA Alonzo will download Non-Drug Exhibit S32.P1 onto a USB, DVD, CD, or External Drive to be compiled with all media evidence from this investigation.

5. This investigation is on-going.

- On April 29, 2021, at 9:02 AM, Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS)
 Criminal Investigations Division (CID) Special Agent (SA) Patrick Alonzo consulted with DPS Emergency Medical Services Manager Jason Dush and DPS Medical Director Doctor Jason Pickett regarding Mackenzie Poston's symptoms.
 - 2. Poston provided SA Alonzo with the following symptoms experienced the morning of 4/2/21:
 - Non-stop throwing up for 2 full days
 - Severe stomach pain, to the point I had to yell to somewhat feel ok.
 - Severe dehydration
 - No appetite for a few days
 - Shaking/body chills
 - Very weak/fatigued
 - 3. Dr. Pickett told SA Alonzo that none of the Poston's described symptoms are consistent with an adulterant (date-rape drug).
 - 4. Medical Services Manager Jason Dush told SA Alonzo that many of Poston's symptoms are consistent with those of the Moderna Covid Vaccine.
 - 5. Dush manages the DPS Operational Medicine Unit (OMU) which has administered hundreds of vaccinations to state employees.
 - 6. This investigation is on-going.

- Criminal Investigations Division (CID) Special Agent (SA) Patrick Alonzo conducted a follow-up interview with Richard Dennis at the Minton Law Firm, 1100 Guadalupe Street, Austin, Texas 78701.
- SA Alonzo video recorded the interview. The recording will be documented as Non-Drug Exhibit S34.P1. Refer to Non-Drug Exhibit S34.P1 for verbatim chronological statements.
- 3. The following is a summary of the interview.

Dennis stated it could be possible that Jennifer Reeves walked with him [Dennis] and Jeff Carlson to the Caroline Restaurant but he [Dennis] only recalled Carlson. Dennis stated that everyone orders for themselves.

Dennis stated he [Dennis] didn't order any drinks for anyone other than himself [Dennis]. Dennis recalled Mackenzie Poston and Reeves ordering their own drinks throughout the night.

Dennis provided verbal consent for SA Alonzo to search his [Dennis'] phone. SA Alonzo did not see the phone number of Dustin Wallace and Lupita Gomez (Austin Club bartenders) saved onto Dennis' phone.

Dennis stated he [Dennis] did not put anything nor saw anyone put anything into Lancaster's, Reeves, or Poston's drink.

SA Alonzo was provided an additional Polygraph Examination Report conducted by Lafayette Instrument Company out of the initiative of Dennis' legal representation. The questions were specifically pertaining to Mackenzie Poston.

 - 3. SA Alonzo at the conclusion of the interview did not deem any information provided by Mauro to be relevant to the initial allegation of assault.
 - 4. SA Alonzo will download Non-Drug Exhibit S36.P1 onto a USB, DVD, CD, or External Drive to be compiled with all media evidence from this investigation.
 - 5. This investigation is on-going.
- On April 29, 2021, Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) Criminal Investigations Division (CID) Special Agent (SA) Patrick Alonzo, concluded the assault investigation and reports the following based upon facts and evidence gathered throughout the investigation.
 - 2. SA Alonzo's investigation shows that during the morning hours of 4/1/2021, Jennifer Reeves and Mackenzie Poston received the 1st dose of the Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine. Later in the evening just before leaving from Representative Landgraf's Office headed to The Austin Club, Reeves and Poston consumed one (1) IPA beer. At 6:20 PM, Reeves, Poston, and Benjamin Lancaster are seen leaving the Capitol.
 - 3. The investigation shows that while at The Austin Club, both Reeves and Poston respectively, consumed a minimum of two (2) Chilton drinks, which would include three (3) vodka shots.
 - 4. Evidence obtained indicates Poston left The Austin Club at 8:03 PM. Poston is 5'0 tall and weighs 120 lbs. The respective consumption of alcohol by Reeves and Poston would have occurred within a three (3) hour window.
 - Evidence shows that after Poston departed The Austin Club, Reeves, Jeff Carlson, and Richard Dennis walked west on 9th Street and then north on Congress Avenue to the Caroline Restaurant. Reeves, Carlson, and Dennis

- sat in the upstairs bar area of the restaurant and were later joined by Jarred Shaffer, invited by Reeves.
- 6. Throughout the course of being at the Caroline Restaurant, Reeves consumed more drinks and it was well apparent that Reeves and Shaffer were not strangers. Reeves and Shaffer were seen showing a heightened level of affection toward Reeves and Shaffer throughout the night.
- 7. Simultaneously, Reeves is actively sharing Reeves' location with Reeves' boyfriend, Mason Pigman. Pigman was repeatedly attempting to call Reeves and at one point arrived outside of the Caroline Restaurant looking for Reeves.
- 8. The investigation revealed that on or about this time, Shaffer drives Reeves back to Shaffer's apartment where Shaffer and Reeves have consensual sex and Reeves spends the night.
- 9. The investigation shows that Reeves woke up at Shaffer's apartment and did not outcry or express any concern to Shaffer, the first person that would have observed Reeves, about being drugged or sexually assaulted.
- 10. The investigation shows that during this time, Reeves and Shaffer had accounted Reeves and Shaffer's symptoms to the combination of alcohol and the COVID-19 vaccine.
- 11. During this same time Reeves sends a text message to Poston asking, "Do you think drinking on the vaccine fucked us?" corroborating Reeves' belief that Reeves' symptoms could be the combination of consuming alcohol and getting the COVID-19 vaccine.
- 12. Simultaneously, in the morning hours of April 2, 2021, evidence shows Reeves contacted Poston, stating that Mason Pigman, Reeves' boyfriend, would be contacting Poston and Reeves needed help with a cover story to justify Reeves' whereabouts. The location that Pigman actively had for Reeves was consistent with the location of Shaffer's apartment complex.
- 13. The investigation shows that in the morning hours of April 2, 2021, Poston woke up with immediate and justifiable concern as to unique symptoms felt from consuming alcoholic beverages the day prior with most if not all of this recollection being available for reconstruction by others.
- 14. The investigation revealed that during this culmination of events which include, Pigman attempting to locate Reeves [Pigman's girlfriend]; Reeves attempting to have Poston create a cover story for Reeves spending the night at Shaffer's house; Poston's legitimate and justifiable concern for the unique symptoms that Poston had never experienced before; and before Reeves' return home to boyfriend Pigman, a concern for being drugged emerges amongst Reeves and Poston. Admittedly by Poston, this concern was further contaminated by the unsubstantiated reputation of Richard Dennis that both Poston and Reeves believed to be true, i.e. rumor.
- 15. The investigation revealed that Reeves arrived home where Pigman was

- awaiting. Reeves reports to Pigman that Reeves believed both Reeves and Poston had been drugged the night before. Pigman drives Reeves to SignatureCare but Pigman was not allowed to enter with Reeves due to strict COVID-19 protocols. During this time, evidence shows Reeves sends a text to Pigman and ultimately Dickson [Poston's mother] that Reeves tested positive for the date rape drug GHB. Evidence obtained during the investigation shows that the information reported to Dickson and Pigman was false as the clinic does not offer the test on-site.
- 16. This continued deception by Reeves further convinced Poston, Poston's mother, and Pigman that the source of Reeves' symptoms was the result of being drugged, consequently making Poston believe the same. Based upon Poston's unique symptoms and false information provided by Reeves, Poston made a report to the DPS Criminal Investigations Division (CID) that Poston believed that Poston had been drugged at The Austin Club when in fact all accounts of what occurred on the night of 4/1/2021 was based upon what others had told Poston.
- 17. At the commencement of the criminal investigation, initial reports were taken to include Reeves' report. Reeves did state that Reeves did not want to make a formal report but did state that Reeves wanted to help and corroborate information Poston made to SA Alonzo. Reeves proceeded to meet with SA Alonzo and provided a recorded video statement with most if not all of the information being inconsistent and deceptive.
- 18. Reeves deceived Poston in making a report to law enforcement with information Reeves knew was not factual. Further, Reeves was deceitful to SA Alonzo in not providing this information for the criminal investigation. Reeves continued to manipulate Poston during SA Alonzo's criminal investigation making Poston feel that Poston should not have come forward due to the accused being influential and very powerful; when in fact, and as acknowledged by Poston, Reeves' discontent with Poston was that Poston coming forward would reveal Reeves' infidelity.
- 19. Evidence obtained showed that at no point, whether before or during the criminal investigation, did the false information that led Poston to report to law enforcement and false accusation take precedent over the discovery of Reeves' infidelity.
- 20. No evidence or facts obtained during the investigation support the allegation of assault.
- 21. All exhibits listed in the investigation were compiled and downloaded onto an external drive. SA Alonzo checked the external drive to ensure all files had transferred properly.
- 22. SA Alonzo placed the external drive into a brown envelope. SA Alonzo sealed, dated and initialed the envelope. SA Alonzo coordinated with entrusted property custodian Lieutenant (Lt.) Daniel Martinez to assign the external drive Property Tag # 7C-21-032. The external drive was transferred into the custody of Lt. Martinez on 5/5/2021 at 1:00 PM.

23. The investigation will be closed pending formal correspondence from the Travis County District Attorney's Office.
